Let's get you up and running with the MIDI Controller plugin for Gen Loss MKII.

Within this folder are 2 support documents:

- Getting started
- Quick guide

And 2 different versions of the MIDI controller plugin:

- Standard plugin (.amxd file)
- Movement rack (project)

### **Requirements:**

You will need both Ableton and a Max for Live license to run the plugin. If you have the Ableton Suite this includes Max for Live by default, otherwise it can be purchased separately.

### **Getting started:**

To get started using the standard plugin, simply drag and drop the MIDI Controller (.amxd file) into your Ableton project.

To get started using the Movement rack, double click on its project folder. You will see an .adg file inside. Again, just drag and drop this into your project.

As long as you've got your MIDI all set up correctly, it's as simple as that.

(Note that while the .amxd file *can* be opened in Max, it will only work correctly within Ableton).
